What is PLQI?

PLQI is a 10-month course designed to build capability and capacity in leading improvement work, with a focus on clinical quality improvement projects. This comprehensive program will help physicians develop their QI knowledge and skills, tap into a rich network of fellow QI champions and receive access to the funding, data, and resources needed to successfully implement quality improvement.

Who should participate in PLQI?

PLQI is designed for active VCH and PHC medical staff. PLQI is for all care settings — including long-term, community, acute and primary care. While participants do not require previous quality improvement experience to take this program, we do recommend applicants to attend the PLQI one-day training.
