

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Lead Physician Mount St. Joseph Hospital Medicine Services Medicine, Older Adult and Palliative Program, PHC

Position Summary:

Providence Health Care's Medicine Program is seeking a physician from the Department of Medicine to serve as the Lead Physician MSJ Medicine Services. This role provides strategic and operational leadership to the Medicine, Older Adult and Palliative Program in partnership with the Patient Care Manager. The Lead Physician MSJ is responsible for ensuring the Program's goals and objectives are achieved by developing, implementing and evaluating strategic and operational plans consistent with the mission and values of the organization.

The Lead Physician MSJ Medicine Services will have the following responsibilities:

- Develop and implement the program's clinical services, in collaboration with the Program Director/team and key external stakeholders;
- Ensure the effective and efficient utilization of program resources (i.e., human, financial and physical), in collaboration with the Program Director;
- Orient new medical staff and oversee medical human resources scheduling, in collaboration with the Program Director, the program team and division head;
- Ensure that the program has in place appropriate medical clinical standards as well as systems and protocols to ensure that medical care is safe and clinical standards are met or exceeded;
- Attend and participate in monthly meetings of the Medicine Quality and Safety meetings and bi-monthly Program Leadership meetings.

The Lead Physician MSJ Medicine Services reports to the Co-Physician Program Director, Medicine, Older Adult and Palliative Program, PHC for operational matters and the Vice President of Medical Affairs, through their Department Head, for academic and professional practice matters.

The estimated time commitment is approximately the equivalent of one-half (1/2) day per week. This position is for a three-year term beginning <u>September 15, 2020</u>, with the possibility of renewal subject to certain criteria. Under this position, the successful candidate would receive a stipend in accordance with the Health Employers Association of British Columbia Medical Leadership Compensation Framework.

- A physician licensed to practice in BC.
- A member of the PHC Department of Medicine in good standing.
- Relevant leadership experience
- Team and system oriented
