

Hospitalist – Urban Health Infection Unit St. Paul's Hospital

The Urban Health Infection Unit (8A) is seeking hospitalists to join our 24-bed unit multidisciplinary care team for day and evening shifts. St. Paul's Hospital is a tertiary care teaching hospital. The Urban Health Unit provides care for patients with HIV/AIDS, plus others with acute infections associated with substance use (e.g. pneumonia, vertebral osteomyelitis, endocarditis). Clinical support is available from the other hospitalist and the infectious diseases physician assigned to the unit on any given day. St. Paul's Hospital has a long history of providing a work place with a collegial environment and delivering patient-centred care.

Position is initially part-time with the possibility of increasing to full-time. Shifts are days (8:00 am to 5:00 pm) or evenings (12:00 noon to 8:00 pm), seven days/week.

Qualified applicants will be licensed (or eligible for licensure) with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of British Columbia (CPSBC), have CCFP certification (or equivalent), and ACLS certification.

Compensation for weekday or evening shifts is \$1,250, and for weekend day or evening shifts is \$1,500. Rates are higher if there is only one hospitalist available on a given day.
