# TERMS OF REFERENCE MAC COUNCIL FOR EXCELLENCE

## **PURPOSE**

- 1. To support the quality improvement of **medical care and medical organization** at Providence Health Care.
- 2. To assist the MAC improve the quality and performance of its work.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Support the MAC to improve the quality and performance of its work in terms of:
  - Advising the Board
  - Improving the safety and quality of medical care
  - Medical staff management, including credentialing, privileges, appointments and reappointments
  - Rules and regulations
  - Risk mitigation
- 2. Recommend improvement priorities to the MAC
- 3. Lead improvement initiatives delegated by the MAC.
- 4. Establish and monitor relevant performance indicators.
- 5. Recommend process improvements, policies, and guidelines to the MAC.
- 6. Ensure that regular quality assurance and quality improvement activities occur in each **Department**. This at a minimum will include review of the following:
  - Deaths occurring in the hospital
  - Statistics regarding patient progress in hospital
  - Methods of treatment of patients in hospital
  - Results of surgery performed in hospital
  - Physician-related issues referred from Programs or the SLT
- 7. Provide support and assistance to Department Heads in terms of their specific quality and performance improvement responsibilities and mandate.
- 8. Work with and support the committee responsible for the quality of medical records
- 9. Ensure alignment of activities with PHC strategic direction and related improvement initiatives.

### **MEMBERSHIP**

- 1. The committee is chaired by the Vice-Chair of the MAC.
- 2. Minimum of 5 MAC members representing at a minimum the following Departments:

- Department of Surgery
- Department of Medicine
- Department of Family Practice
- Department of Emergency
- 2. Chair, MAC (Ex Officio)
- 3. Director, Health Records
- 4. Director, Medical Affairs
- 5. Member of the Performance Improvement & Measurement Group
- 6. Other members as required

## TEAM SUPPORT (as needed)

1. Director, Performance Improvement & Measurement
