Vancouver Coastal Health (VCH) is seeking expressions of interest from suitable qualified candidates for the position of Regional Medical Director, Quality & Safety, VCH.

#### **Overview**

Reporting to the Associate Vice President, Medicine, Quality & Safety, VCH and in collaboration with the Executive Director of Quality and Patient Safety and Infection Prevention and Control VCH, the Regional Medical Director will provide leadership and direction to quality, safety and risk.

The Regional Medical Director will collaborate with the Associate Vice President, Medicine, Quality and Safety and the Executive Director, Quality and Patient Safety and Infection Control to create a meaningful approach to learn about system-level opportunities for improvement within VCH. This approach should engage healthcare providers in a new collaborative way while promoting a culture of learning. The Regional Medical Director will support practices, initiatives, and facilitate partnerships that prevent, identify, and resolve patient safety and quality issues. Through involvement with various VCH Advisory councils, quality committees, and point-of-care leadership, the Regional Medical Director will collaborate with physicians, clinical teams, operations, and leadership to implement regional systems that achieve a culture of quality and safety by:

1. Embedding team-based quality improvement and safety,
2. Providing point-of-care teams with valid, reliable, timely, and meaningful data,
3. Ensuring and building capacity and capability of quality improvement and safety methods, tools, and approaches throughout the organization, and
4. Building quality collaborative structures that foster communication, support, and partnership.

#### **Remuneration**

Remuneration for this position, paid as a stipend, will be commensurate with experience and the agreed upon administrative time commitment.

#### **Qualifications**

Licensed physician in the Province of British Columbia. A level of education, training and experience equivalent to a Master's preparation in Health, Business Administration or related health discipline, plus ten (10) years practice and management experience in a medium to large sized, complex health care organization.
