St. Paul’s Hospital is seeking psychiatrists in the Chronic Pain Service at St. Paul’s Hospital. The focus is on treatment of patients through the Complex Pain Centre and who have co-morbid mental health illness.

The Complex Pain Centre consists of a well-established Interdisciplinary Team of experienced clinicians from Anesthesia, Psychiatry, Internal Medicine, Physical and Rehabilitation Medicine, Family Medicine, Psychology and Allied Health professionals including nursing, physiotherapy and occupational therapy.

The service would encompass an Outpatient Service, Consult Liaison as well as teaching in a busy clinic and hospital setting. Ideally, experience in Pain Medicine and/or Addiction Medicine would be essential to successful candidates.

Remuneration would be a mixed sessional and fee for service model. The work involves performing comprehensive pain assessments, working in a multidisciplinary team, providing individual or group psychotherapy and providing medical treatment including pharmacotherapy. There is also opportunity for developing basic procedural skills in pain management.
