Expression of Interest Family Physicians

Position Summary

Within the context of a patent and family-centered model of care, and in accordance with the Mission, Vision, Values and strategic directions of Providence Health Care ("Providence"), is seeking up to two Family Physicians to join the John Ruedy Clinic (Primary care for HIV positive individuals) at St. Paul's Hospital (SPH) in downtown Vancouver. PHC's John Ruedy Clinic has been providing longitudinal primary care to individuals living with HIV that are medically or psychosocially complex for over two decades. The Program also provides supervision and teaching to a variety of medical trainees including (but not limited to): medical students, residents, fellows and enhanced skills trainees.

Successful candidate will be require to work a minimum of 1 full day per week or alternatively 2 half days per week to a maximum of 2 days per week. Physicians will be fully supported by a comprehensive interdisciplinary team and attach a longitudinal panel of patients. Physicians are supported by nursing, social work, psychiatry, phlebotomy, and peer navigators.

Qualifications

Successful candidate will be Licentiates of the Medical Council of Canada and hold a current BC Medical License with the College of Physicians & Surgeons of BC (CPSBC), and meet credentialing requirements at PHC (this includes sign-off from the applicant's respective Department Head). Applicants with experience in addiction medicine and or HIV medicine will be prioritized. Educational opportunities are available for interested candidates without HIV medicine expertise. Experience working with multidisciplinary teams is an asset.

The successful candidate will also exemplify Providence's values and contribute to a culture of equity, diversity, and inclusion. In addition, Providence is committed to our responsibilities on Truth and Reconciliation. We hold ourselves accountable for making our care, facilities and services a safer experience for Indigenous patients, residents, families, staff and Medical Staff.

Compensation and commitment:

Physicians receive blended compensation through either Medical Services Plan billing or hospital sessional support for services provided.
