Where do you take the training? All the information you need to take training is available on the public facing site: <u>https://cpocus.ca/acute-care-core/</u>, and scroll down to "Sign up for a course" - which is the second heading.

How much is the training? Understand that CPOCUS is the accrediting body and doesn't design the courses. Individual companies have their own POCUS courses that they charge their own fees; the CPOCUS website simply lists the courses that are accredited. You can find these courses as well as their respective prices on the link above. Most courses range anywhere from \$1500 to as high as \$7000.

And how long is the training? Specific to initial competence acquisition, it really depends. Most POCUS courses are a couple of days. But the components to acquire certification demands that you return demonstrate to the approval of an instructor your image generation and interpretation as well as clinical integration competence (usually about 50 of each). Then, you write an exam and perform a visual exam. How long the training is depends on the course you take.
