Position Summary

Within the context of a patient and family-centered model of care, and in accordance with the Mission, Vision, Values and strategic directions of Providence Health Care ("Providence"), is seeking two physicians **to share joint leadership** of the Mount Saint Joseph Internal Medicine group. The two roles are:

- (1) MSJ Associate Head of Medicine and MSJ Assistant Lead Physician of Medicine
- (2) MSJ Lead Physician of Medicine and MSJ Assistant Associate Head of Medicine

Mount St Joseph Hospital (MSJ) is the primary site for this Providence IM role that bridges internal medicine work at both PHC sites. This physician will be leading a cohesive team of Internists engaged in quality patient care and teaching in a community setting, most of whom also work at St Paul's Hospital. This position bridges two of PHC's acute facilities, MSJ and SPH. MSJ is a PHC acute care facility in the Mount Pleasant neighborhood of Vancouver, with 200 beds and serves a diverse population and SPH is a 500 bed clinical academic teaching hospital in downtown Vancouver.

This is a co-lead role with joint and shared responsibility to the Department of Medicine of PHC and to the Medicine Program of PHC. An office space and administrative support will be provided. Successful candidate will be required to work 5 hours per week, an equivalent to a 0.125 FTE.

Qualifications

Successful candidates will be Licentiates of the Medical Council of Canada, hold a BC Medical License and current certificate with the College of Physicians & Surgeons of BC, and meet credentialing requirements at PHC. Qualified applicants will be licensed (or eligible for licensure) with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of British Columbia (CPSBC), have RCPSC certification, and ACLS certification. Applicants with three years of US training in Internal Medicine or Hospitalist Medicine are specifically encouraged to apply through the expanded licensing pathway available from the CPSBC.

The successful candidate will also exemplify Providence's values and contribute to a culture of equity, diversity, and inclusion. In addition, Providence is committed to our responsibilities on Truth and Reconciliation. We hold ourselves accountable for making our care, facilities and services a safer experience for Indigenous patients, residents, families, staff and Medical Staff.
