

Expression of Interest On-call Locum General Surgeon, Mount Saint Joseph Hospital

Position Summary and Qualifications

Within the context of a patient and family-centered model of care, and in accordance with the Mission, Vision, Values and strategic directions of Providence Health Care ("Providence"), the Division of General Surgery (Department of Surgery) is seeking General Surgeons for On-call services on a locum basis at Mount Saint Joseph Hospital ("MSJ"), to start in the first quarter of 2024.

Due to clinical restructuring within the Division of General Surgery, MSJ is offering on call opportunities to fellowship trained General Surgeons (preferably with endoscopy skills).

The locum will be expected to take 1 week of Acute General Surgery and Acute GI bleed call beginning at 8 am on Fridays. They will be responsible for all general surgery inpatients, consults from the emergency department and wards, and emergency surgeries and endoscopies. At the conclusion of the week of call, the surgeon will handover all inpatients to the oncoming on call surgeon. The surgeon will transfer all outpatient follow up to an incumbent MSJ General Surgeon.

Emergency surgery and endoscopy time is available typically following the elective surgery and endoscopy slates. There is capacity for call back surgery as well. There will be no elective OR or endoscopy time available to the locum.

We anticipate the need for roughly 10-16 weeks of call relief in 2024.

During the week of call, the locum will receive Level 1 MOCAP and may bill fee for service for all clinical encounters.

The successful candidate will also exemplify Providence's values and contribute to a culture of equity, diversity, and inclusion. In addition, Providence is committed to our responsibilities on Truth and Reconciliation.
