





# SUBMISSION GUIDELINES 2024 PHC-PASS Pillar-Focused Engagement Project Funding

Dear Providence Medical Staff,

In recognition of medical staff interest in opportunities for project funding, the PHC Physicians & Surgeons Society (PHC-PASS) and medical staff Pillar Advisory Committees (PACs) will be accepting proposals **for Pillar-focused engagement projects and initiatives** from eligible medical staff groups/departments/divisions beginning on February 19, 2024. The application deadline is March 18, 2024 at noon.

- Each Pillar Medical Advisory Committee has a total of up to \$5000 available to fund selected projects.
- Projects must be completed by March 31, 2025

## Eligibility Criteria:

- Project proposals must align with:
  - Goals and Objectives of **one** Pillar Advisory Committee (PAC) (link to review objectives for each PAC):
    - Exceptional Quality Safety, Value
    - Inspiring People & Teams
    - Discover, Learn & Innovate for Impact
    - Partnerships
  - Facility Engagement (SSC) Funding Guidelines (as of Sept 2023)
  - One of three Facility Engagement goals.

## Limitations:

- Funding thresholds:
  - Quality, Safety, Value projects = maximum \$5000
  - Inspiring People and Teams projects = maximum \$2500\*\*
  - Discover, Learn & Innovate projects = maximum \$5000
  - Partnerships projects = maximum \$5000

\*\*The Balance of the People Pillar's project funds are being applied to a PAC-driven medical staff engagement initiative, detailed to be announced in Spring 2024.

### How can the funding be used?

- Physicians' time for project planning, implementation, & evaluation.
- Non-physician medical staff/allied health staff time outside regular working hours.
- Project supports (e.g. admin assistant).
- Meals/catering related to project activities.
- Indigenous engagement: project participation, consultation, cultural work, and/or meeting attendance by elders or knowledge-keepers.

## What is excluded? (the following is ineligible for funding)

- 1. Projects already completed.
- 2. Research.

- 3. Clinical equipment for direct or indirect patient care.
- 4. Work falling within the usual scope of a formal health authority (HA) physician leadership role.
- 5. Meeting attendance required to maintain privileges.
- 6. Work otherwise compensated through the HA/PHC.
- 7. Work otherwise excluded in accordance with Facility Engagement (SSC) Funding Guidelines.
- 8. Remuneration for medical staff or PHC staff delivery of direct & indirect patient care.
- 9. Travel or parking costs for physicians, other medical staff, PHC staff.
- 10. Gift cards.

#### **Important Dates:**

- **Proposal Intake Deadline:** Monday, March 18, 2024 at noon. Late applications will not be accepted.
- **Funding Decisions:** All applicants will be informed of the funding decision by April 15, 2024.

#### Approval Steps and Follow-up:

- Each application will be reviewed by the specified Pillar Advisory Committee (PAC) and PHC partners, to evaluate and score against a standard framework. The PHC-PASS team will notify applicants of their funding status by April 15, 2024.
- Some organizational supports will be available for successful projects to enable project implementation (e.g. data analytics through Corporate Development, Innovation projects can access resources available through <u>Ideas Forward</u>).

\*For project budgeting purposes, at current FE Physician Sessional rate (\$171.05/hr):

\$5000 = 29 hours of physician time \$2500 = 14.5 hours of physician time \$1000 = ~6 hours of physician time
