





Planetary Health Strategy Advisory Group One Physician Partner Role Available

PHC is creating their first Planetary Health Strategy. Building on the work of <u>CASCADES</u> and our other partners in the BC health system, we will be developing a strategic plan that supports PHC's efforts to reduce their impact on the environment and promote a more sustainable future.

We are creating a small advisory group from across the Office of Strategy & Results, Facilities Management Office, and the Quality teams and are seeking a physician partner to join us. The objectives of the group are to:

- Advise on engagement approaches
- Review current strategies and emerging findings (results of engagement) and advise on strategic directions.
- Review and provide feedback on the draft strategy.

Estimated level of commitment:

- We anticipate a total of 6 hours of engagement including attendance at four 6o-minute meetings and two hours of preparation time (e.g. reviewing meeting material).
- Meetings will be scheduled to accommodate the availability of the Physician Partner and other advisory group members.

Remuneration:

- The Physician Partner will receive payment to participate in and prepare for Advisory Group meetings, at the Specialist Services Committee Facility Engagement sessional rate.
- Funding will be provided by PHC Physicians & Surgeons Association (PASS).
