



Cross-Site Internal Medicine Physician

focused on Mount St. Joseph Hospital (Half-Time role)

Providence Health Care (PHC), in Vancouver, is seeking a General Internal Medicine (GIM) physicians for 24 weeks of service per year to start in October 2024, though there may be ad-hoc opportunities for temporary or provisional work earlier depending on availability. This position is based at Mount St. Joseph Hospital (MSJ), though opportunity may be present to also work at St. Paul's Hospital. MSJ is a PHC acute care facility in the Mount Pleasant neighborhood of Vancouver, with 200 beds and serves a diverse population. SPH is a 500-bed clinical academic teaching hospital in downtown Vancouver.

Position Summary

This PHC Internal Medicine (IM) role has a commitment of 24 weeks per year. MSJ is the anchor site for this PHC IM role. This physician joins a cohesive team of Internists engaged in quality patient care and teaching. While students and residents are not always present, there is an opportunity to pursue further academic and teaching interests. There is also an opportunity to participate in outpatient clinic work at MSJ.

The General Internal Medicine role will involve the following:

MSJ ROLE DESCRIPTION AND CLINICAL EXPECTATION:

1. MSJ IM Half- Time coverage is defined as 24 weeks of inpatient work per year.
 - i. Coverage expectation is 7 days a week, Monday to Sunday with option to have weekend locum coverage if locum available.
 - ii. MSJ IM Core members have priority access to inpatient schedule.
 - iii. MSJ Core IM group cover any gaps in schedule including holidays, weekend rounding and call, and sick coverage with equitable holiday/March break/summer coverage across the years.
 - iv. Payment is fee for service, with income stabilizer for inpatient ward rounding and MOCAP for on call.
2. Ambulatory Internal Medicine
 - i. IM ambulatory Clinic work is option.
 - ii. IM core group have priority access to Ambulatory clinic schedule.
 - iii. Payment model is exclusively fee-for-service.

 - ii. Q2months M&Ms rounds which are mandatory activity at PHC.
 - iii. Participation in MSJ QI work and MD feedback.
 - iv. Participation in projects to benefit the MSJ IM Core group - may take lead on project work.
 - v. Leadership interest at MSJ or across both MSJ and SPH an asset.

1. Optional SPH IM work is available, if desired.
